

## 1 JOHN 3:19-23

## EXODUS 14:1-15

<sup>1</sup> Now the Lord spoke to Moses, saying:

<sup>2</sup> Speak to the children of Israel, so that they turn and camp before Pi Hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea, before Baal Zephon. Opposite it you shall camp by the sea. <sup>3</sup> For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel,

“They are confused in the land. The wilderness has shut them in.” <sup>4</sup> So I will harden Pharaoh’s heart, so that he shall pursue them. And I will be honored because of Pharaoh and because of all his army, so that the Egyptians may know that I am the Lord. And they did so.

## EXODUS 14:1-15

<sup>5</sup> When it was told the king of Egypt that the people fled, the heart of Pharaoh and of his servants was turned against the people, and they said, “Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us?” <sup>6</sup> So he made ready his chariot and took his people with him. <sup>7</sup> And he took six hundred select chariots, and all the chariots of Egypt, and officers over every one of them. <sup>8</sup> The Lord hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the children of Israel. However, the children of Israel went out with confidence.

## EXODUS 14:1-15

<sup>9</sup> But the Egyptians pursued after them, all the horses and chariots of Pharaoh, and his horsemen, and his army, and overtook them camping by the sea, beside Pi Hahiroth, before Baal Zephon. <sup>10</sup> When Pharaoh drew near, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and indeed, the Egyptians were marching after them, and they were extremely terrified, so the children of Israel cried out to the Lord. <sup>11</sup> Then they said to Moses, “Is it because there were no graves in Egypt that you have taken us away to die in the wilderness? Why have you dealt with us in this way, bringing us out of Egypt?”

<sup>12</sup> Is not this the word that we spoke to you in Egypt, saying, ‘Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians’? For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness.”

<sup>13</sup> But Moses said to the people, “Fear not! Stand firm! And see the salvation of the Lord, which He will show you today. For the Egyptians whom you have seen today, you shall never see again. <sup>14</sup> The Lord shall fight for you, while you hold your peace.”
